



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE SUPPORT PERSON SERVICE AND PREVENTION OF CORONAVIRUS INFECTION IN SKIEN MUNICIPALITY.

The Support person service in Skien municipality follows the basic rules for infection control that are in line with the recommendations of [The Norwegian Institute of Public Health](#) and [The Norwegian Directorate of Health](#).

1. Ensure good hand hygiene, and otherwise follow guidelines for infection control according to the above links.
2. Activities and meetings should preferably take place indoors with a distance of two meters, good cleaning of hands and surfaces. However, we recommend that meetings take place outdoors if possible, and then at a distance of one meter.
3. Support persons can go for walks with users in wheelchairs, with impaired vision/hearing and others with special needs for contact closer than one meter. Face masks **must** be used in these cases.
4. Users can be brought along in a car provided there is a good distance and cleaning of surfaces following a drive. It is recommended that passengers sit in the back seat.
5. Avoid being together if the Support person or user has symptoms of respiratory infections or suspects coronavirus infection.
- 6. NB! Report as soon as possible to the Support person or Adapted recreation service [Tilrettelagt fritid] in the event of a detected infection or suspicion of infection.**
